

European Royalty Connected to Ukrainians:

AGATA of KYIV, Agatha of Wessex (1030 - +1093) Queen of England. AGATHA (Agafia) Yaroslavna. She became the ancestor of all British monarchs, including the legendary Richard the Lionheart.

Wife of King Edward, daughter of the Grand Duke of Kyiv Yaroslav the Wise and Ingigerda - daughter of Swedish King Olaf III,

Mother of Edgar Etheling and St. Margaret - Queen of Scotland. This granddaughter of Yaroslav the Wise became the first Scottish saint.

Agatha's sisters:

Queen ANNE Yaroslavna of France, wife of King Henry I;

Queen of Hungary ANASTASIA Yaroslavna (Agmund), wife of King András I;

Queen of Norway ELISAVETA Yaroslavna (Ellisif), wife of King Harald III the Strict, then wife of King Svein II of Denmark.

Agatha's brothers:

Prince VSEVOLOD Yaroslavych, husband of Princess Maria, daughter of the Byzantine Emperor Constantine IX Monomakh (1046), Vladimir Monomakh was born from marriage;

Prince IZYASLAV Yaroslavych, husband of Princess Gertrude, daughter of Polish Prince Mieszko II (1040);

Prince SVYATOSLAV Yaroslavych, husband of the German Countess, granddaughter of Emperor Henry II, Emperor of the Holy Roman Empire;

Prince IHOR Yaroslavych, husband of the German Princess Kunigunda, Countess of Orlamind;

Prince VYACHESLAV Yaroslavych, husband of the German Princess Oda Stadenska;

Prince VOLODYMYR Yaroslavych, husband of the German Countess Oda, daughter of Grand Count Lipold von Stade.

In the chronicles the mention of Queen AGATA dates back to 1066.
