

Palace of Labour, Kharkiv

The Palace of Labour is recognized as an architectural and urban planning monument of local importance, built in 1916. On March 2, 2022, a missile strike from Russia targeted the Palace of Labour, simultaneously causing damage to the building of the Executive Committee of Kharkiv City Council, situated on the right side.



House of Merchant Adam Piotrowski, Kharkiv

The building, designed in the Ukrainian Art Nouveau style, was erected in 1912 and holds the designation of an architectural and urban planning monument of local importance. Today, it functions as office space for delivering administrative services to the city's residents. On August 27, 2022, a missile strike by Russia targeted Kharkiv, resulting in damage to the building's facade.



Municipal Enterprise "Saltivske Tramvaine Depo" Kharkiv City Council

Since the beginning of the full-scale war, the Saltivske tram depot has been under constant shelling from Russia. As a result, most of the city's rolling stock has been damaged or put out of service.



House of Judicial Institutions, Kharkiv

In 1902, the House of Judicial Institutions was constructed on Skobelev Square (now known as Heroes of the Heavenly Hundred Square) based on the design by architect O.M. Beketov. At that time, it was the largest structure in the city of Kharkiv. Tragically, on March 6, 2022, a Russian missile struck the road adjacent to this building.



Kharkiv Polytechnic Institute

Sports Complex of the National Technical University

The construction of the sports complex spanned from 1985 to 1991. It stands as the sole sports facility in Ukraine to receive the State Prize of Ukraine in the Field of Architecture and has served as an Olympic training base for the Ukrainian national teams. Tragically, on June 24, 2022, the building was destroyed by Russia.



Regional State Administration Building, Kharkiv

The administrative building, erected in 1954, is situated in the heart of the city at Freedom Square. It holds the designation of an architectural and urban planning monument of local significance. On March 1, 2022, Russia executed a missile strike on the structure, resulting in casualties. A second attack occurred on August 28, 2022.
