Do you need further support?

Ask the United for Ukraine Support Line for your local IRC contact. Your local office may be able to provide:

- Housing assistance
- Transportation orientations
- Seasonal clothing
- Vaccinations and health screening required for parole applications
- Referrals to doctors, medical care, and medication
- Enrollment for school-aged children
- Referrals to English classes
- Cultural Orientations
- Assistance applying for public benefits such as cash assistance, food assistance, SSI, WIC, and health insurance coverage
- Assistance applying for documents such as a Social Security Card or Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
- Referral to employment services
- Human Trafficking and intervention and assistance
- Referrals to other short and long-term case management programs, services, and benefits as applicable
